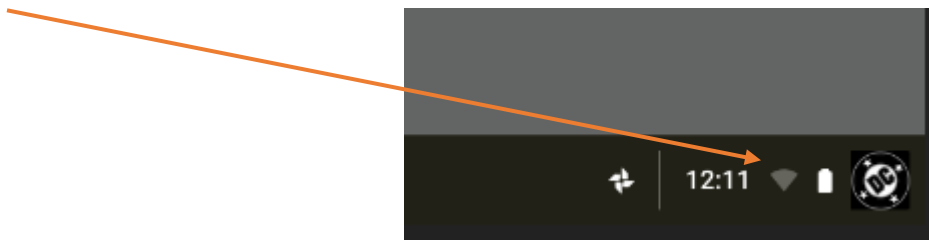


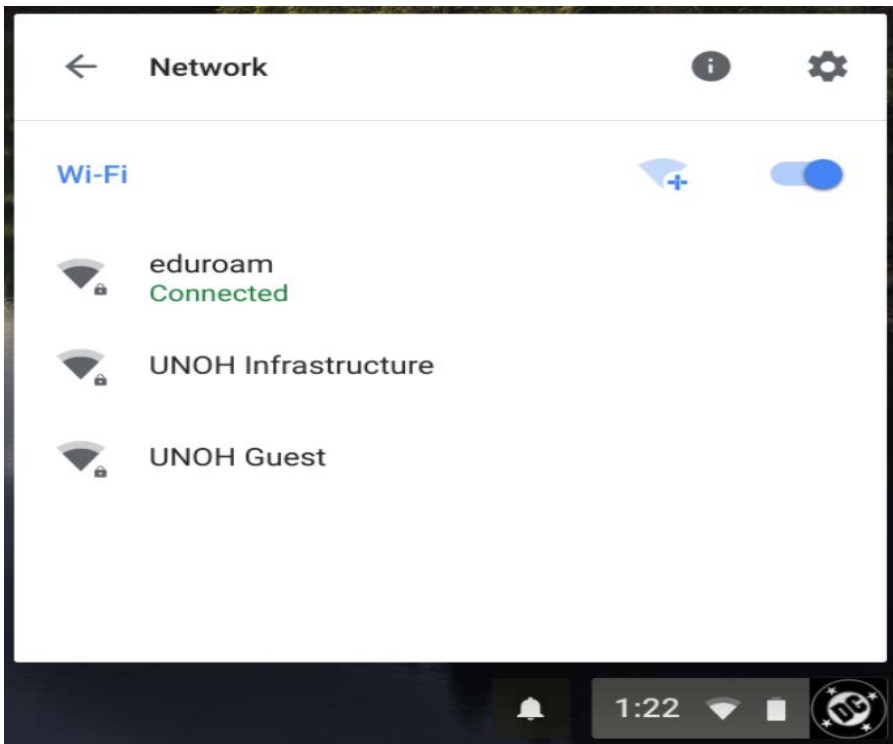


HOW TO: Connect to Eduroam on a Chromebook

1. Click the WiFi icon at the bottom right of the screen.



2. Click and select eduroam from the menu.
